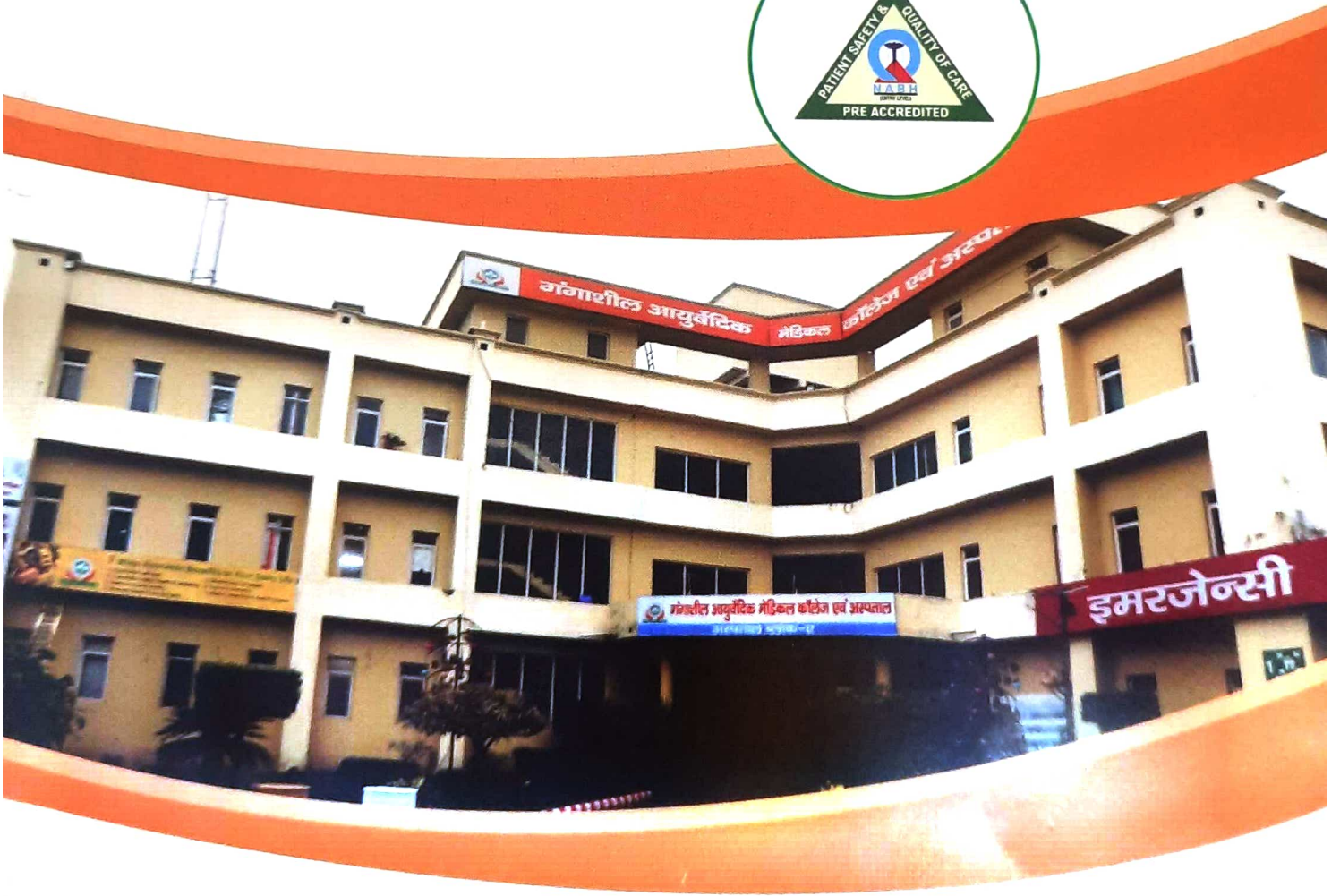

Gangasheel Ayurvedic Medical College and Hospital is committed to providing a safe and secure environment for all its students. The college strictly prohibits any form of ragging, which is defined as "any disorderly conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student, or indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or any other student."

Ragging is a criminal offense and is punishable under the law. Students and parents/guardians are hereby informed that strict action will be taken against any individual(s) involved in ragging activities. This may include suspension, expulsion, fine, imprisonment, or any other legal action as deemed necessary by the college.

All students are required to abide by the following code of conduct:

- Respect the rights and dignity of all students and staff members.
- Refrain from any form of ragging, bullying, harassment, or discrimination.
- Report any instances of ragging to the college authorities immediately.
- Cooperate with the college authorities in their efforts to prevent ragging.
- Sign an undertaking against ragging at the time of admission.

Any student who witnesses or is subjected to ragging is encouraged to immediately report the matter to the college authorities. The college has a zero-tolerance policy towards ragging and will take all necessary steps to ensure the safety and well-being of its students.
